ESSAY

Please submit, along with this application, a double-spaced, typed essay, with your name and page number on each page. In your essay, please address the following three topics:

- Describe your educational and career goals. Why did you choose this career path? What challenges do you anticipate in preparing yourself for it? Technology has allowed us to accomplish far more in less time than ever before. Can you envision how it might affect your profession and you in the future?"
- Describe a project, composition, or other educational activity that has been particularly important to you. How has it affected you? (Examples might be a Science Fair or Senior project, a History or English composition, or reading an influential book).
- **Other than a family member**, please name an individual who has been influential, and describe the impact he/she has had on your life. (No relatives, please.)

IMPORTANT:

The essay will determine if you qualify for a personal interview. Essays with fewer spelling and grammatical errors will receive higher scores. Remember that "spell check" does not catch everything. It is perfectly fine to ask a friend, family member, teacher, etc. to review your essay.

NOTE:

As a non-profit organization, San Dimas Rodeo, Inc. is required to mail scholarship checks directly to the educational institution. Funds will remain available for three years from date of award.

Although participation in the rodeo or the ability to ride a horse is not required, please be advised that a general information question regarding rodeo will be presented during the interview process.
