- Please name an individual who has been influential, and describe the impact he/she has had on your life. (No boyfriends/girlfriends, please)

IMPORTANT: The essay will determine if you qualify for a personal interview. Essays with fewer spelling and grammatical errors will receive higher scores. Remember that "spell check" does not catch everything. It is perfectly fine to ask a friend, family member, teacher, etc. to review your essay.

NOTE: As a non-profit organization, San Dimas Rodeo, Inc. is required to mail scholarship checks directly to the educational institution. Funds will remain available for three years from date of award.

Although participation in the rodeo or the ability to ride a horse is not required, please be advised a general information question regarding rodeo will be presented during the interview process.
